## Didactics of Greek Traditional Dances (ΔA0600)

## **Learning Outcomes**

Upon successful completion of the course students:

- will have acquired the knowledge and skills for performing Greek Traditional Dances,
- will be able to perform in practice representative dances from different regions of Greece,
- will have understood the basic principles of didactics for teaching Greek Traditional Dances,
- will be able to apply in practice the basic principles of didactics for teaching the dances that will have been taught.

## **Course Content**

- •Students' initiation in Greek dancing tradition and familiarization with the rhythms and kinetic expressive means of Greek tradition.
- •The learning of the basic principles of didactics.
- •The learning of dances from departments of mainland Greece (Macedonia, Thrace, Epirus, Thessaly, Peloponnese).
- •The learning of dances from Greek islands (Aegean islands, Ionian islands, Crete).
- •The learning of dances from areas of Greek origin (Pontos, Eastern Romylia).

## **Course Evaluation**

The assessment is based on students' regular and active participation in the course (10%), midterm exams (20%) and oral, written and practical exams at the end of the semester (70%).
